1. Simonsblanc, Simonsvlei Paarl – South Africa

Pear & apricot aromas and crisp, balanced acidity.

2. Tempranillo/Garnacha Rosado, Montesierra D.O. Somontano – Spain

Dry yet bursting with mouth-watering red berry fruits.

3. Simonsrood, Simonsvlei Paarl – South Africa

Smooth dark fruit flavours with a smoky spicy edge.

Complex yet refined with intense flavours of apricot and honey combined with subtle floral notes & cinnamon spice – simply delicious!

5. Sauvignon/Semillon Chateau des Eyssards Bergerac – France **£18.50**

Mouthwatering gooseberry fruit from the Sauvignon Blanc rounded out by the richer Semillon varietal with a citrus edge.

6. Pinot Grigio, Canal del Ronco, Banear D.O.C. Friuli-Grave – Italy **£17.95**

Classic Pinot Grigio from a top-notch producer in North East Italy - dry and delicate with a lemony character and subtle nuttiness.

7. Sauvignon Blanc, Con Class, Ricardo Sanz Rueda – Spain **£19.95**

Intense fruit aromas of passion fruit with green grass hints follow onto the palate with a delightfully lengthy citrus finish.

8. Chenin Blanc, Simonsig Estate Stellenbosch – South Africa **£15.95**

This wine wins awards year after year, so we had to keep it! Tropical guava fruit, apple flavours and slight spice.

9. Single Vineyard Chardonnay, S Hackett Barossa Valley – South Australia **£21.95**

An elegant , well rounded wine with a rich tropical fruit flavoured palate and well integrated oak.

10. Riesling, Winemakers Reserve, Confin Maule Valley – Chile **£18.95**

This single vineyard looks out over the permanently snow-capped mountains of the Andes and yields a full flavoured wine with fresh flavours of citrus, mineral & floral notes.

11. Viognier Single Vineyard, Tekena Rapel Valley – Chile **£18.95**



Intensely aromatic with distinctive apricot and peach aromas. Ripe and rounded on the palate with a twist of zesty citrus.

12. Chateau Parenchere Clairet Bordeaux – France **£19.95**

Aromatic yet elegant Bordeaux Rosé from the Gazaniol family. An equal blend of Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon produce a dry full flavoured Rosé with a raspberry and red cherry character.

13. Chateau Montaguillon Bordeaux – France **£24.95**

A delicious, supple, red fruit character of plums, blackcurrants & cherries with firm, ripe tannins.

14. Valpolicella Classico Superiore, L Righetti Veneto – Italy **£21.95**

Rich & complex, thanks to the infusion of Amarone lees known as the Ripasso method! Black cherry & raspberry aromas, dark chocolate notes & smooth silky tannins.

15. Rioja Bordon Crianza, F Espanolas Rioja – Spain **£19.95**

Having won medals at the recent Decanter World Wine Awards, as well as the International Wine Challenge and with a high "88 points" rating from Robert Parker, this wine is sure to impress!

16. Crozes Hermitage, Yann Chave Rhone – France **£14.95**

A good concentrated red made from 100% Syrah/Shiraz with smooth integrated tannins and a peppery finish.

17. Syrah, Bradgate, Jordan Winery Stellenbosch – South Africa **£17.95**

100% Shiraz this full bodied wine has been matured in French oak barriques. Sweet, ripe dark fruit flavours with nuances of crushed pepper and a spicy, smoky finish.

18. Cabernet Sauvignon, Simon Hackett McLaren Vale – South Australia **£22.95**

Ripe & concentrated with smoky blackcurrant fruit, well integrated firm tannins and layers of cedar spice.

19. Zinfandel, Painters Bridge Sacramento Delta – California **£19.95**

Enticing, spicy red fruit nose and a jammy, brambly, medium bodied, soft palate with an elegantly juicy finish.

20. Merlot/Petit Verdot, Brookford South Eastern Australia **£18.95**

A superbly juicy wine offering, showing good plummy fruit flavours from the predominant Merlot and a touch of spice from a little Petit Verdot.

21. Prosecco Brut, Banear D.O.C.G. Valdobbiadene – Italy **£19.95**

Now reclassified under strict European regulations, Prosecco's top region, Valdobbiadene produces this fresh and fruity, easy drinking sparkler.

22. Ackerman "1811" Brut Rose Saumur – France **£19.95**

Deep rose in colour and made using the Cabernet Franc grape. This delicious fizz shows enticing red fruit aromas and delightful summer fruit flavours on the palate.

23. Kaapse Vonkel Brut, Simonsig Estate Stellenbosch – South Africa **£19.95**

Using the same techniques as Champagne production as well as a classic blend of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Menieur this wine has recently been voted as the best South African sparkling wine.
